1. <b>Le Havre de Paix, Côtes de Gascogne, France 2015</b> Soft, fruity and very easy to drink.	£18.90
2. <b>Santa Lucia Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile 2015</b> Fresh and crisp white with flavours of lemon and grapefruit.	£19.90
3. <b>Pinot Grigio, Calusari, Cramele Recas 2015</b> Light, zesty, dry and moderate in alcohol, a deserved favourite.	£19.90
4. <b>Nostros Chardonnay Gran Reserva, Chile 2015,</b> A powerful nose of soft vanilla, tropical and citrus fruits and nuts leads to a refined palate that is very well balanced.	£24.50
5. <b>Viognier, Domaine de la Baume 'Elizabeth', Pays d'Oc, France 2015</b> The palate is voluptuous but retains a refreshing acidity. The finish is long, slightly honeyed and very pleasing.	£23.50
6. <b>Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine La Serre, France 2015</b> Known as the "Chablis of the South", the wines of Picpoul de Pinet are crisp, bright and refreshing. The name Picpoul, literally translates as "Lip Stinger"	£28.00
7. <b>Taringi Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2016</b> A classic nose of gooseberries and fresh cut grass. The mid weight palate is filled with ripe tropical fruits and a hint of oiliness.	£29.00
8. <b>Macon Villages, Pierreclos, Domaine Marc Jambon et Fils 2014</b> Vines reaching 40 years in age. Everything here is done by hand and gravity. Rich, fat and very Burgundian, as good as it gets in Macon.	£30.00
9. <b>Gavi del Comune di Gavi 'Gold', La Scolca, Piemonte, Italy 2015</b> Full bodied yet refreshing, a wine with notes of green fruit and a strong mineral core.	£32.00
10. <b>Chablis, Tour de Roy Vieilles Vignes, Domaine des Malandes, France 2015</b> Absolutely classic Chablis from this excellent producer - beautifully balanced with firm sappy apple fruit, steely minerality and savoury character which lingers for ages.	£36.00
11. <b>Sancerre, Croq'Caillotte, Domaine Emile Balland 2014</b> This wine is named Croq'Caillotte after the limestone pebbles which are found only in the best Sancerre vineyards. It is certainly worthy of the name, with its vibrant citrus acidity, herbaceous grassiness, and elegant gunflint minerality.	£39.00
12. <b>Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, Les Chenevottes, Jean Noël Gagnard, France 2014</b> A nose with tropical fruit including pineapple and guava lead to a palate with gentle acidity and plenty of stone fruit characters. Smooth oak shows as vanilla pod and a hint of smoke.	£75.00

15. <b>Les Volets Malbec, Haute Vallée de l'Aude, France 2015</b> Very smooth French Malbec, big but gentle.	£22.90
16. <b>Navajas Rioja, Spain 2015</b> This is Rioja at its precocious youthful best, with intense raspberry and black cherry.	£25.50
17. <b>'The Wrong Un' Shiraz/ Cabernet, Adelaide Hills, Australia 2014</b> Black fruits, vanilla spice and cassis, rich and rounded, and very pleasing to the palate.	£25.50

20. <b>Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Vieilles Vignes, Albert Bichot, France 2013</b> A well-balanced red, enhanced by discreet woody notes and a pleasant finish.	£30.00
21. <b>Chianti Classico, Ormanni, Italy 2012</b> Soft, very well structured, full, fleshy, with a good volume, long and lingering finish.	£35.00
22. <b>Contino Rioja Reserva, Spain 2010</b> Classy palate showing juicy, herbal fruit with a delicious vanilla sweetness.	£48.00
23. <b>Barolo, Bricco Ambrogio, Paolo Scavino, Italy 2006</b> Rich, this is classic Italian fayre. Bright cherry, earth, leather, spice and herbs.	£55.00
24. <b>Gevrey Chambertin 'Clos de la Justice' Monopole, Vallet Frères, France 2011</b> The nose which is gently spicy, lightly perfumed, a little bit earthy and very 'traditional'. The palate has delicate flavour and complexity.	£60.00
25. <b>Château Dauzac, 5ème Cru Classé, Margaux. Bordeaux, France 1996</b> Dauzac is of outstanding quality, and gets to the heart of what is great about not only the Margaux region, but also Bordeaux itself. Made with great care, the wines are always complex and expressive with pencil lead minerality, cedar wood, tobacco smoke and superb blackcurrant fruit.	£95.00
